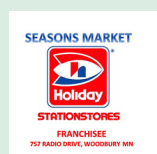

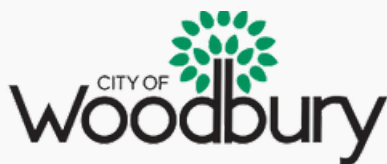

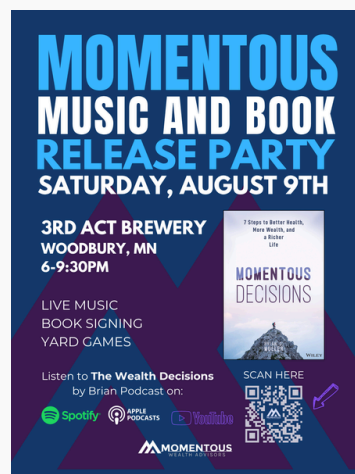


SWCTC Announces New Name, TrueLens Community Media
